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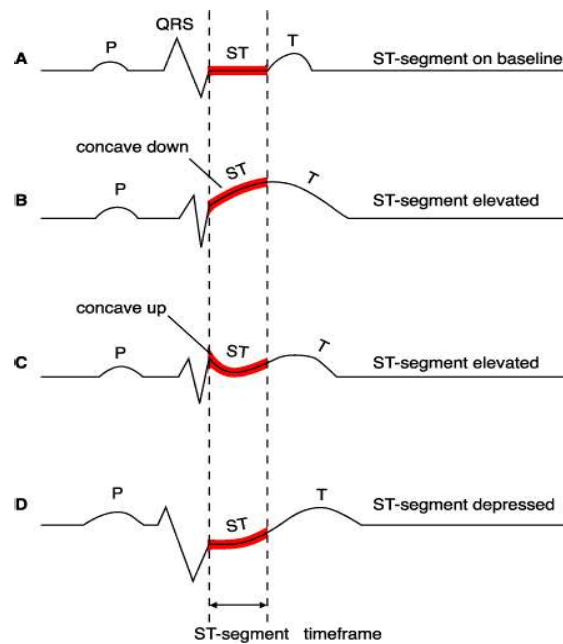
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## Significant ST Elevation



### CRITERIA FOR ST ELEVATION

1. Present in 3 Consecutive Beats
2. ST elevation 1mm (small box) above baseline in limb leads
3. ST elevation 2mm (small boxes) above baseline in chest leads
4. Must be present in at least 2 contiguous leads
  - i. I, aVL, V5, V6
  - ii. II, III, aVF
  - iii. V1, V2
  - iv. V3, V4
